



General Safety Courses

Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG)

4 Hours

A comprehensive set of regulations, which is now in effect, must be respected when transporting dangerous goods. This course provides a simple guide for employees to enable them to understand and comply with the regulations. A three-year certificate is awarded. Registration is required one week prior to start date of course.

Workplace Hazardous Material Information (WHMIS)

4 Hours

Provincial legislation requires that employers offer this course to all employees. It is especially critical for those who work with compressed gas, oxidizing, poisonous, toxic, infectious, and corrosive or dangerously reactive materials. Registration is required one week prior to start date of course.

H₂S Alive

8 Hours

Hydrogen sulphide (H₂S) safety training is mandatory for all people who wish to work in the Canadian upstream petroleum industry (prior to refinery). Enform's H₂S Alive! Safety training program has been the standard in the Canadian upstream petroleum industry. Topics covered include properties and locations, seven step initial response strategy, respiratory protective equipment, detection and monitoring, rescue techniques, artificial respiration and case studies.

Fire Suppression S-100

8 Hours

The Worker's Compensation Board of BC requires all workers to be trained before fighting a forest fire and also requires workers that fight forest fires to be retrained annually. In addition, the BC Forest Service requires that anyone conducting an industrial operation in a forest to be trained for fighting forest fires. This course meets BC Forest Service and WCB regulations. This course is designed to introduce students to fire suppression. Topics include an introduction to wildfire, fire behaviour, fireline safety, communications, use of heavy equipment on fires, and the operator's role in fire suppression. The use of tools and equipment, and water delivery systems is included. This course provides a one-year certification in Fire Suppression. A short examination is given at the end of this course and successful participants will receive formal proof of completion.
