Admission requirements

1. Grade 10 reading level (at a minimum). Available through the College.
2. A handwritten statement describing your understanding of the role of a Health Care Assistant 150 words).
3. Submission of an RCMP criminal records search.
4. Submission of completed immunizations & screening for TB and Hepatitis B .

Once all admission requirements have been met students will be accepted on a "first qualified, first accepted" basis.
