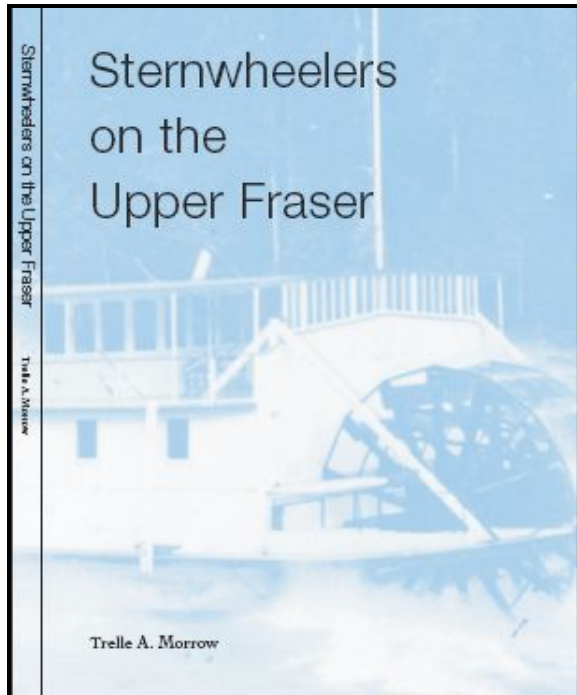

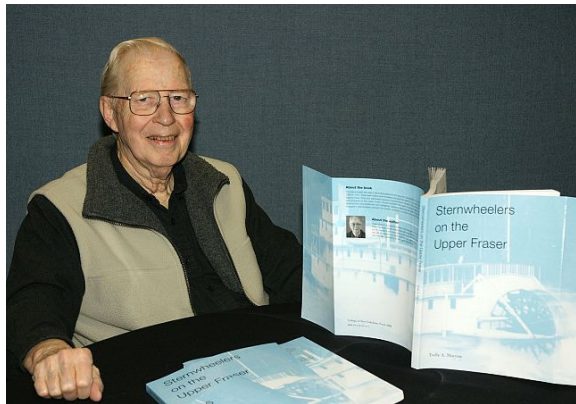
Sternwheelers on the Upper Fraser

The sternwheeler era was a fascinating period in the history of Central British Columbia. From 1863 to 1921, there were twelve sternwheelers that plied the waters of the Upper Fraser River at varying times. This book addresses aspects of social history relevant to sternwheeler construction and operation on the Upper Fraser. Social contexts in the realm of resource exploitation, railway development and settlement are highlighted. Specific references are made to individuals engaged in sternwheeler transport as owners, operators, or simply as innocent travelers.

Trelle Morrow is a retired architect whose life-long philatelic interest has led to research into early mail services, aviation history and now sternwheeler operations on the Upper Fraser River.
