

Instructional Skills Workshop

This workshop will provide you with the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare and deliver effective instruction. You will learn to use a variety of techniques that will enhance effectiveness to communicate and increase student learning. You will create and conduct a series of three mini-lessons in class. As “students” during peer lessons, you will provide feedback and guidance to fellow students who deliver the lessons.

You will be giving your first lesson on the second day and may have homework in order to prepare. When selecting topics for mini-lessons, you must consider college policy and the sensibilities of course participants. Due to the nature of this course and the requirement for peer group feedback, you must attend a minimum of 95% of the classes to satisfy attendance requirements.

This course gives you credit through Vancouver Community College (VCC) for the Provincial Instructor Diploma Program (PIDP 3220). Send a copy of your Instructional Skills Workshop certificate and required fee to VCC to receive the credit.
